


## Things to know about Obertauern

### Cross-country skiing


#### GNADENALMLOIPE

A fantastic high-altitude trail awaits you here at 1350 metres above sea level. It stretches over approx. 20km and offers all levels of difficulty levels of difficulty in "skating" and "classic".  
 NEW: The biathlon shooting range on the the Gnadenalm offers - biathlon for everyone.  
 Length: approx. 20km



#### HUNDSFELDLOIPE

North of the sports centre is the access point for this sunny this sunny cross-country ski trail. The most beautiful part extends across the nature reserve of the Hundsfeldmoor and ends with a rapid descent towards the sports centre. Another access point to the Hundsfeldloipe is located in the immediate vicinity of the kite centre.  
 Length: approx. 6km



#### WELTCUPLOIPE

The entrance to this promising, moderately difficult cross-country ski tra can be found at the Zehnerkar car park P2. From the Zehnerkar valley sta to the Felseralm you can enjoy the landscape and tranquillity of the Weninger Au.  
 Length: approx. 6km



### **LANGLAUFLOIPE TAURACH**

The 12km long easy to moderately difficult trail connects Untertauern and Radstadt. Obertauern is therefore not only THE ski resort in Salzburger Land, but also a cross-country skiing cross-country skiing paradise for beginners, advanced, semi-professionals and real experts at the same time. On the various cross-country trails there is something for everyone.

Length: approx. 12km



### **TWENGER AU**

The longest cross-country ski trail connects the villages of Tweng and Mauterndorf.

The entry points: Franzenbauer in the centre of Tweng,  
at the timber yard in Tweng Lantschfeld,  
opposite the Purnbauer farm in Vordertweng and at the Maly bus stop.

Length: approx. 23km
