

## Interesting facts about Obertauern

### Hiking

Whether you prefer short, exciting excursions or long-distance hiking trails, there is something for everyone in Obertauern. 280 kilometers of well-signposted hiking trails offer a wide variety of routes for hiking enthusiasts.

If you want to climb the peaks in Obertauern, it is worth checking the difficulty of the hike in advance. The difficulty classification of a trail is based on the most difficult section up to the specified destination.

To make your hiking experience safe and enjoyable, please also take into account current weather conditions and any trail closures.

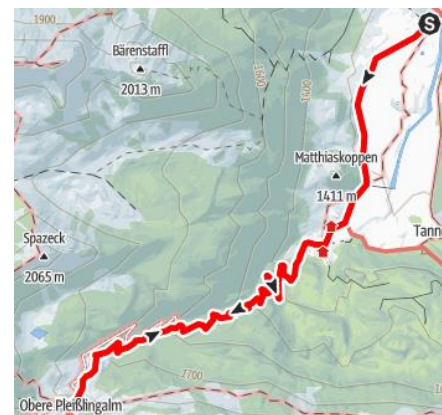
### A few hiking routes – suggestions:

#### **SÜDWIENERHÜTTE**

9,7 km, 520 hm, 4:00 h, easy

Leisurely hut hike via the Hintergnadentalm

Wonderfully situated, an attractive hiking destination, but is also a popular starting point for other hikes such as Spirzinger, Spazeck or Großer Pleißingkeil



#### **3-LAKE HIKE**

6,1 km, 370 hm, 2:45 h, easy

Either on foot or with the Grünwaldkopfbahn you reach the Grünwaldsee - the first of the 3 lakes, from there a short walk to the Krummschnabelsee, then down to the Hundsfeldsee, past the Dikt'n Alm



### TWENGER ALM-ROUND

13,1 km, 530 hm, 4:45 h, medium

A leisurely hiking trail takes you in the direction of Hundsfeldsee, before the path leads over the Edelweissalm to the Twenger Alm, along beautiful paths via the Ernsthütte to the Twenger Alm



### OBERHÜTTEN-TOUR

15,9 km, 1.060 hm, 7:30 h, medium

Long but varied tour, starts in Obertauern and first leads to the Seekarscharte then down into the neighboring Forstautal valley to the Vögeialm, return hike back up to the Oberhütte and via beautiful beautiful natural paths back to the Seekarscharte



### GURPITSCHECK-TOUR

13,3 km, 1.440 hm, 8:45 h, hard

Long and strenuous, but beautiful mountain tour, requires alpine experience, especially in the summit area. You start from Tweng through the forest to the Hofbaueralm, across the alpine meadows to the Twenger Almsee lake and the alpine summit ascent. The descent is via the Twenger Alm down to Obertauern.



### PLEISSLINGKEIL-RUNDTOUR

18 km, 1.330 hm, 9:00 h, hard

This circular tour requires basic knowledge of mountaineering and absolute surefootedness. The ascent to the summit with its breathtaking mountain panorama via the Südwienener Hütte, on the descent you hike to the Wildsee and later past the Johannes waterfall.
